Credits: 1

Course Title: Dental Therapeutics

Course Description: Exposes students to concepts and terminology related to pharmacology, pain control, and dental medicinal agents. Emphasizes use of materials in patient treatment. Prerequisites: DNA 100, DNA109, DNA 103, DNA 108, DNA 113, and DNA 120. Lecture 1 hour per week.

General Course Purpose: DNA 119 will prepare the student with the terminology and procedures concerning anesthesia, medications, and syringe preparation.
